

Ecofloor in Golden Lane in Prague

The Golden Lane at the Prague Castle was festively opened after a year-long reconstruction on 1st June 2011. The main objective of the reconstruction commenced in May 2010 was to repair the obsolete rain water drainage system. The situation was serious as the status of the system was endangering the structural stability of the individual buildings.

During the renovation, a complete reconstruction of all underground services and internal wiring inside the total of 16 period houses was carried out. The whole renovation cost approximately CZK 34 mil, additional CZK 5 mil were invested in restoration works.



One of the basic requirements for the planned reconstruction was the use of the equipment and appliances that will in no way intervene with the character of the existing houses and at the same time will not require any significant interventions into the structure of the houses (request raised by the preservationists). Therefore, electric floor heating was selected for heating of the buildings, which fully complies with the above mentioned requirements thanks to its installation method and zero maintenance needs in the future. Finally, we may say with pride that it was our ECOFLOOR heating mats that have been chosen for the reconstruction of this historically very important location.
